Promotion and Placement Requirements

as per the district's Student Progression Plan

15-18 Cumulative middle school courses passed:

PROMOTED to

9th grade -

- 3 Language Arts courses
- 3 Math courses
- 3 Science courses
- 3 Social Sciences
- plus electives (including PE)

Eligible for high school admission

14 or fewer courses passed

Retained in 8th grade

High School Credit(s)

Students in Middle School can earn a maximum of six high school credits

- Algebra 1 Honors* (must pass EOC)
- Geometry Honors* (must pass EOC)
- Physical Science Honors
- Biology* (must pass EOC)
- Spanish for Spanish Speakers 1 & 2
- Spanish for Non-Spanish Speakers 1 & 2
- French 1 & 2

*EOC results 30% of grade

Note: Students in middle school who earn a "C" or below in a high school course may retake the course for grade forgiveness.

Taking High School courses while in Middle School impacts:

- High School GPA (grades will show up on transcripts)
- Graduation and College admission
- Scholarship opportunities, including Florida Bright Futures
- NCAA Eligibility (Athletics)

DIPLOMA OPTIONS

- A four-year, 24-credit standard program
- 18-credit Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning (ACCEL) option

TWO ADDITIONAL ACCELERATED graduation OPTIONS

- An International Baccalaureate (IB) program*
- An Advanced International Certificate of Education program*

STATE ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS:

10th grade FSA Language Arts

End of Course (EOC) ASSESSMENTS:

- Algebra 1, Geometry, and Biology 1, U.S. History
- Pass with a Level 3 or higher to earn course credits
- EOC results are 30% of final course grade
